IN CASE YOU MISSED IT (ICYMI)


Two fantastic falls events combined into one weekend!

MINORITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

The committee's most exciting project to date has been taking on an active role in APTA PA's efforts to increase minority participation in Pennsylvania PT/PTA schools through the "ADAPT" Scholarship offering up to \$10,000 to schools dedicated to increasing the diversity of their programs. This scholarship was inspired by Dr. Gregory Hicks ADAPT program at the University of Delaware, which works towards ensuring that all students, regardless of background, are well-prepared to pursue a graduate physical therapy education. Winners were announced in October. Congratulations to all the ADAPT scholarship winners including two of our own from the SED:

- Neumann University, Aston, PA (\$8,000)
- University of the Sciences, Philadelphia, PA (\$6,000)
- DeSales University, Center Valley, PA (\$6,000)
- The University of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh, PA (\$10,000)

Each school will be providing the committee with periodic updates with the intent to speed the implementation of effective and creative program approaches to help support the creation of a more diverse practitioner base within the Commonwealth. Look for another round of ADAPT awards in 2022 all supported by YOUR member dollars!
